

Important Information for Junior Hunters

1. All hunt participants must wear blaze orange and eye protection while in the field.
2. Be aware of your zone of fire and others around you. Do not take unsafe shots.
3. No animals other than pheasants may be taken, caught, killed, captured, or pursued by any dog or person.
4. Do not place loaded shotguns in, or upon, any vehicle whether it is moving or stationary.
5. Hunting licenses must be in each hunter's possession for hunt registration and while hunting.
6. Shotguns shall hold no more than 3 rounds in the magazine and firing chamber, combined.
7. No shot size larger than 7 1/2, i.e. no 6's, 5's, or 4's. No magnum loads are permitted.
8. Please pick up all trash and empty shells. Even if it's not yours, please help keep the property clean.
9. Do not pursue a pheasant that leaves your assigned field.
10. There will be no ground shooting of birds.

I understand the responsibility placed upon me as a participant of the Debra Takayama Memorial Junior Pheasant Hunt. I will comply with all rules prescribed herein as well as all safety standards related to hunting and the use of firearms.
